

Applying for sendmenow missions

***New:** Students will be expected to pay for their own visas, inoculations, and medications!

Step 1

Be sure that you've read the following documents.

Required Dates: You must be able to meet important, specific dates throughout the entire process. Please look below to see if those dates are compatible with your schedule. Please note the **Application Deadline.** We are posting the dates well in advance for you to place them on your calendar. The dates with stars by them are mandatory! If there is a schedule conflict, please call and discuss it with Warren Skinner-ASAP!

January 15th - deadline for application! MIDNIGHT
(THIS is the ACTUAL Deadline!!)

January 22nd - deadline for (4 references, plus a campus minister interview form, photo (digital), History of Abuse form, & Child Protection Form

Qualifications: sendmenow has a responsibility to many people-to students, parents, missionaries, churches, and various other organizations. We take that responsibility seriously; therefore students who serve are expected to meet certain qualifications. Please read our qualifications and contact us if you have questions.

Policy Agreement: Being a Baptist Student Missionary involves a high level of responsibility and influence. Because of this, certain standards of moral conduct and behavior are expected of every missionary. Please click on "Policy Agreement" to read the policy agreement and determine if you are willing to commit to its requirements.

Step 2

Application: Begin our application process by clicking on "[Apply](#)". You will choose the "individual" application. Then you will be able to create a password and complete the application over a period of time. When your application is complete you need to print a copy of your application and references. Only after completing these steps are you ready to submit your application. Be certain that you click to submit your application to "**Georgia BCM**" and make doubly certain that you click "**SUBMIT**." Please note that once you have submitted the application, you will not be able to log back into it.

* Submitting your application early helps our process immensely. Applications will be **accepted up to the deadline of January 15**, but please make every effort to apply earlier. You do not have to type in a project number...just the name of the place you want to serve from the SendMeNow list.

Step 3

Send in References:

Four References- On the "[reference](#)" part of the online application, you can download the reference forms. This page also tells you exactly who should fill out the forms. The campus minister interview form is to be filled out by your **BCM campus minister**, in addition to the 3 reference forms! ***After January 6th ALL three references will be online and will not be in the paper or email form. You will login and send references within the system.
