

# Be Careful not Fearful

Our goal is that you will learn how to be careful for the sake of the national believers and career missionaries. But do not be ruled by fear. Fear is not of the Lord. If you are careful and follow all of the World A rules, there is not reason to be fearful!

If you are allowed to take a Smart Phone, Tablet or Computer (ask supervisor) you must "Clean It" before you go.

#### This means

- Disabling all email accounts but your World A.
- Taking off all photos, but those you have chosen to take to show new friends (Photos of your family, friends, campus, hometown.)
- Clean out old texts.
- Disable Twitter, Instagram and Facebook, etc. on your device.
- Take off apps that are of a religious nature. You CAN keep a Bible app on your phone.

### Ask yourself this question:

"If my device were viewed by an authority, is there anything on it I would not want them to see or that could be harmful to the M's in country?"

#### POSTING PHOTOS AND VIDEOS:

Please think before you post or send out photos!

- **NEVER** post or send out a photo with one of the "m's" or national believers in the photo or video. If you write about a friend you have shared with, do NOT post their picture with that story.
- **NEVER** post photos or videos showing religious activities, like baptism, worship, or national holding a Bible.
- **NEVER** post pictures that identify where you are. Ex: standing in front of the Pyramids, Great Wall, or Taj Mahal.

## World A Communication Checklist

- Set up a new World A Email address.
- Give the address to your GATEKEEPER and SendMeNow ONLY.
- Have a plan with your gatekeeper as to how you will communicate with them (from World A email) and how they will communicate with your family, friends and Partners in Missions.
- Save SMN World A email. This is the email address 99smn68@gmail.com we will use to communicate with you while on the field.
- Clean up any phone, tablet or computer you will be taking with you. (Some places will not allow you to bring any of these. ASK supervisor.)
- Get a new **Facebook** account (if you will be allowed to use Facebook).
- Ask your supervisor the best way to talk/communicate with your family.
- While on the field try NOT TO BE USING TWITTER, INSTAGRAM, FACEBOOK OR OTHER SOCIAL MEDIA.
